I would like to address the present letter to the European Anti-Fraud Office (OLAF) as the last institution, that can examine the correctness of expenditure of the financial aid provided by the European Union.

The letter concerns financial aid on the basis of pt 3.3. Investments in fishing ports, unloading spots and landing places. Operational program “Balanced development of the fishing sector and coastal fishing areas 2007 – 2013”.

As of 17/11/2015 our association sent a letter to ARiMR (**see Attachment No. 1**).

The mentioned letter thoroughly describes and provides the documentary evidence for conditions which unequivocally indicate the irregularities that forbid the investment settling.

Taking into account, that we have not received any answer within a one month administrative period, we reckon that ARiMR desires to cover up the case, since their actions were a major cause for the current situation.

The members of the Kosakowo Commune Residents' Association are convinced that the irrational ways of financial aid expenditure, as described in the attached documents, may be influenced by corruption factors.

The attached documents, may not fully indicate the direct examples of corruption, as this usually is difficult to prove, but they surely present a multimillion aid waste which could only be possible due to personal and political connections of the Kosakowo Commune municipality workers, members of Agency for Restructuring and Modernisation of Agriculture, based in Warsaw, with a division in Gdynia (further referred to ARiMR) and companies executing the investment.

If the above case is not within the competence of OLAF we kindly ask to redirect our letter to the suitable institution, which is in control of the correctness of financial contracts settlement.
